Meeting held at Alpharetta High School on Sunday, May 3, 2015

New business was discussed next:

- Education Event – Preview Day
 - Rick Subel discussed his idea about creating a preview day in the fall which would serve as an education event
 - Directors would bring their show concepts to the event to discuss with designers, other directors, or mentors
 - This event could serve both WGI-bound groups in addition to local-only groups.
 - A request for dates for the event will be sent via e-mail to directors to save the date well in advance to improve attendance
- Placing committee names on website



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- Steering Committee members for each group will be added to website once they have been chosen
- SAPA Championships for 2016 will be held at the UTC McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga, TN on April 1 – 3, 2016
- Multiple show sites per weekend
 - Discussion was held regarding the possibility of having multiple show sites each weekend. The final decision depends on how many units register for SAPA next year.
- Recap sheets for critique
 - Discussion was held regarding providing the individual recap sheets for directors going into critique immediately following the final performance of the day.
 - An idea to assist with this would be to not have the first critique time begin until the start of the award ceremony (occasionally the critique would begin before the award ceremony starts). This would allow the tabulation table the time to get the necessary paperwork and numbers into the system.
