Changes to Colorguard A Class Finals at WGI

At the recent annual WGI Board of Directors meeting, it was unanimously approved to expand the world class championships for A Class colorguards. The proposal features moving A Class Finals to Wright State University's Nutter Center on Saturday morning, to run concurrently with Open Class Finals in the University of Dayton Arena.

Changes in the A Class Expansion include:

- Scholastic A finalists will increase by 50%, from 15 units to 24 units
- Independent A finalists will increase from 15 units to 20 units
- Performance schedule will better mirror both Open and World classes – Preliminary performance on Thursday, Semi-final performance on Friday,

and Finals performance on Saturday morning

Other approved proposals at the meeting:

- Addition of a fourth judge to the Percussion division
- U.S. military veterans enlisting before their 19th birthday will be granted an additional year to any age rule eligibility in all three divisions (Percussion, Winds, and Colorguard)

Important Policy Manual Updates

This year, some important changes to the policy manual were approved by the general membership at the meeting in May.

Changes include:

- An attendance tally at all SAPA member events will begin this year. Director passes

will only be provided to active members of the circuit in 2017 (see policy manual for details)

- Any policy which is changed/added regarding classifications must not be amended/updated

until the next competitive season

- Vice President of Winds was added to the Executive Board
- Colorguard Scholastic A National class was added – these units must attend 1 WGI Regional AND National Championships

• Colorguard Scholastic A units must now only compete locally and will be eligible for promotion to Scholastic A National should the unit attend a WGI Regional AND National competition.

• If there are more than 16 units in a class at SAPA Championships, the class will be split into multiple divisions of 16 units each, and the divisions will be filled by

odd or even rankings as detailed in the policy manual
