PARKING: South Forsyth High School is undergoing major construction. There is no on campus connector between the Main Parking Area (for performing units) and the Sporting Event Parking (for visitors and guests).

Performing Units (Main Parking Lot)

- Enter from Peachtree Parkway (Main School Entrance).
- Unload in designated Load/Unload area (See Map)
- Parking personnel will be on duty to direct you to the load / unload area and to check-in.

Visitors/Guests

- Enter from Ronald Regan Blvd entrance and park in Visitor Parking (See Map)
- Follow signs to Main Gym.

UNIT CHECK-IN: Shown on the map enclosed. Be prepared to declare the number of competing members. Penalties will be assessed for false declarations. Competing members and seven staff will be provided arm bands for entrance plus 7. Additional members and staff must purchase arm bands for \$9. Units must check 90 minutes prior to performance time.

Unit members and Staff must check in together.

DRESSING FACILITIES: Available on-site. Please vacate ASAP after performance. Please do not leave valuable personal items in the dressing area. Please leave the dressing area as clean and neat as when you arrived. Personal belongings will be stored in school hallways.

FOOTWEAR AND EQUIPMENT PROTECTION: All equipment tips on rifles, pikes, and sabers must be taped (including PVC pipes). Any props used must be protected as not to damage the floor (even if a floor covering is used). **Shoes must be worn at all times with the exception of the performance.**

EQUIPMENT UNLOADING & STORAGE: All equipment will be unloaded in the designated areas. There will be equipment storage in the designated areas. The areas will be identified on the enclosed map, and someone will be there to assist you. *Please reload all equipment as soon as your performance is over.*

FLOOR SIZE: The site will have a minimum of sixty-five by one hundred feet (65' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five feet (5') on both sides and back using the minimum competition area of sixty feet by ninety (60' x 90').

FLOOR REFOLDING: Floor refolding will take place in the parking area next to the performance area. There will be guidance to that area at the end of your performance.

PERFORMANCE MUSIC: Please provide your unit's performance music to the sound coordinator immediately following unit check-in. Formats accepted are CD or MP3. Sound testing and volume control will be managed by SAPA. If you have an iPhone or iPod Touch, please be sure to have another way to play your music at shows (another iPod, mp3 player, or cd).

TIME LINE: We will have a horizontal time line. From the judge's perspective, units will enter the right rear and exit on the right front. The floor will be pulled from the rear sideline to the front. Upon entry you may pull the floor to the halfway point, and then await notification from the timing judge to proceed.

RETREAT LINE UP: The warm up gym will be where the CO's will line up for retreat.

SCORE SHEETS AND RECAPS: These can be picked up after the contest at the sound table area.

AWARDS: The top 3 in each SAPA Class will receive awards.

CRITIQUE: Critique will be located in the media center, which is located adjacent to the unit check-in area at the front of the school.

SPECTATOR ADMISSION: Per SAPA guidelines, admission will be **\$9.00** for one day pass for patrons. Upon payment you will be given a armband which must be worn around the wrist and visible for admission to the gym. There will be a separate spectator entrance that will be clearly marked.

WARM-UP AREAS/ The Warm up area is designated on the map. Body warm-up and equipment warm-up will be in the west hall gym behind check-in. The guards will stay in one area for the full warm-up time. The west hall gym is a full gym with appropriate height for equipment work.

UNIT GUIDES: Upon check in, every unit will be assigned a volunteer Unit Guide. While we respect that you may have done this for years and do not feel you need the services of a guide, to ensure the safety of the units and their timing of movement throughout the school, please understand every Unit must have a guide. Your Unit Guide will meet you in your designated hallway 20 minutes prior to your scheduled body warm up. You will be escorted to body warm up at the appropriate time. The Unit Guide will stay with you through your performance. A volunteer guide will escort you from mat refolding back to the personal belonging storage area. Timing for each area is determined by the published SAPA schedule.

HOSPITALITY: Our hospitality room will be available in the bandroom throughout the contest. This room will be open to Directors, Staff, Bus Drivers and Judges ONLY as identified by their respective badges. We will be serving hot food, drinks and snacks.

CONCESSIONS: The Concession area will be open throughout the competition with a wide variety of great food/drinks available for your enjoyment.

FIRST AID

We will have a nurse station manned by a trained medical personnel throughout the contest. They are aware of the contest and are on-call if we have any medical needs. If you have a first aid need, please contact a Staff Member immediately, so that the appropriate action can be taken.

If you have any questions, please contact us prior to the contest. During the contest, in addition to the Directors, your Unit host and contest staff should be able to assist you with your questions.

Take I-85 South (toward Atlanta)
Take exit 111 for GA-317 N toward Suwanee (0.2 mi)
Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto GA-317 N/Lawrenceville-Suwanee Rd (0.3 mi)
Turn left onto Northolt Pkwy (0.6 mi)
Turn right onto McGinnis Ferry Rd (6 mi)
Turn right onto GA-141 N (6.2 mi)
South Forsyth High School will be on the right

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Directions from Chattanooga / I-75 South

Take I-75 South (toward Atlanta)
Use the right 3 lanes to take exit 259 for I-285 E toward Greenville/Augusta (1.3 mi)
Merge onto I-285 (1.4 mi)
Keep left to stay on I-285 (4.5 mi)
Take exit 27 to merge onto US-19 / GA 400 N toward Cumming (21.3 mi)
Take exit 13 for GA-141 (0.3 mi)
Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto GA-141 S (1.0 mi)
South Forsyth High School will be on the right (0.4 mi)

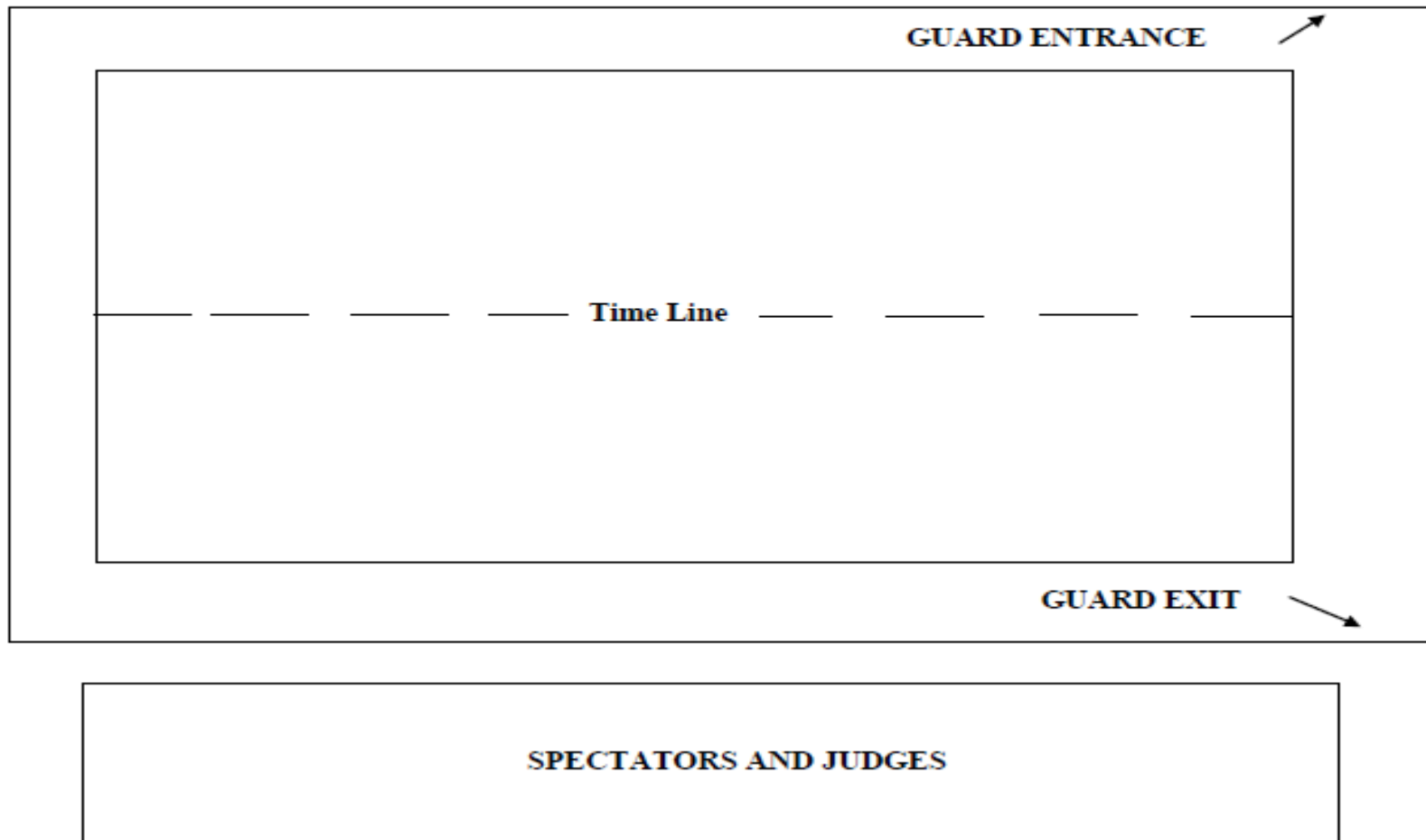
